BUT overcome they did when they performed at the Holland Dance Spektakel they were placed an impressive 3rd. Repeating the performance in the Polish Open Championships they came 1st. They also took part in the first French Open Championship in Lyon, placing 2nd in the Standard championship. They have continued to compete in Ballroom Championships in Netherlands and Poland as well as once again in the German Open Championships.

Later this year they will take part in the Malta Open Dance Spectacular 2024 which Steve also helps organise. This event is attracting dancers from around the world including dancers from U.S.A. and Brazil as well as many countries from Europe. This year people with learning difficulties from Poland as well as Slovakia and U.K. will also take part, giving them the opportunity to participate with all dancers.
